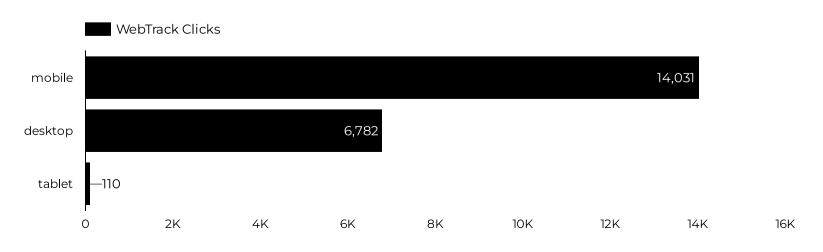

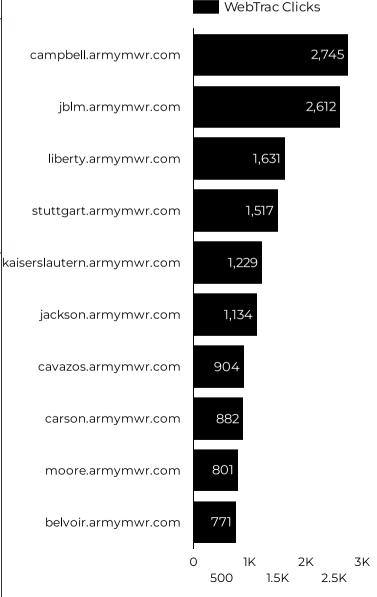


Which devices are driving engagement?

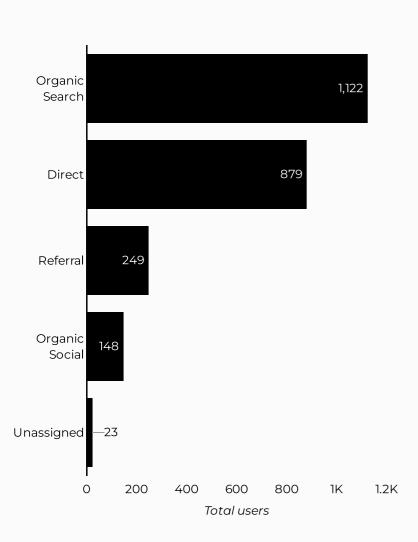
