




Aquatics Centers Program Section Update Instructions

Below are instructions for how and where to plug in installation-specific content into the new Aquatics Centers Program section.

Aquatics Center(s) Page


On the bottom of the Aquatics Center(s) page, there are 9 different example Aquatics Centers as locally-editable placeholder content. These are three instances of the "Feature List" block with three facility entries each.

Please delete as many blocks and Aquatics Center entries as you need to match how many you will need. For instance, if you have 5 centers, you would delete the bottom block entirely, and then edit the second Feature List block and remove one of the facility entries using the "x" button.



Then, for each facility you will need to:

- Create a Program Content subpage for each of your facilities. Refer to the General Program Page Update Instructions document and video for guidance for creating those.
- Edit these feature blocks and for each facility:
 - Add the Title for the Facility
 - Leave the icon field blank
 - Add a picture
 - Add a description
 - Choose “Page” as the link type
 - Link to the Program Content subpage you created
 - Use “Learn More” for the link text
- Only add a maximum of 3 facilities per row, please.





Aquatics Classes and Programs Page


