SUBJECT: IMCOM Policy Memorandum 215-1-7, IMCOM G9 Better Opportunities for Single Soldiers (BOSS) Program

1. References:

- a. DoD Instruction (DoDI) 1015.10, Military Morale, Welfare, and Recreation (MWR) Programs.
- b. AR 215-1, Military MWR Programs and Non-appropriated Fund Instrumentalities (NAFIs).
- c. AR 600-20 Army Command Policy.

2. Purpose. This policy supersedes previous policies that prescribe guidance and directives associated with the implementation, updates, and execution of the IMCOM G9 BOSS Program Standard Operating Procedures (SOP). This policy directs all IMCOM garrisons and supported organizations utilizing IMCOM G9 Better Opportunities for Single Soldier (BOSS) Programs to execute within the guidelines of the BOSS Standard Operating Procedure (SOP). This policy will be used to ensure proper administration, compliancy, and internal controls among IMCOM personnel in accordance with both new and enduring operating guidance.

3. Applicability. This policy is applicable to all IMCOM personnel and supported organizations linked to the support of single Soldiers and the execution of the BOSS Program.

4. Procedures.
